

Registration

All meeting participants will receive a badge that will be issued to delegations by organizers on arrival at the venue. All participants must wear their badges visibly at all times during the meetings.

If you lose your badge, please notify the organization team immediately.

All personal information provided during the accreditation will be processed exclusively in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) obligations mentioned in the Czech Presidency GDPR Memorandum, which can be found on the Presidency website and in the accreditation system itself.

Only accredited delegates will be able to access the meeting venue.

Transportation

How to get to the venue from the train station

From the main train station, Hlavní nádraží, take the red metro line C in the direction of Háje. At the stop Muzeum, change to the green metro line A in the direction of Nemocnice Motol. Get off at the stop Staroměstská, the venue is a 5-minute walk from the metro.

How to get to the venue from the airport

The Václav Havel Airport Prague is served by the public transportation https://www.prg.aero/en/public-transport-buses. From the airport, take bus number 119 to the final stop Nádraží Veleslavín. There change to the green metro line A in the direction of Depo Hostivař. Get off at the stop Staroměstská, the venue is a 5-minute walk from the metro.

At the expert meeting, you will receive a ticket for the Prague public transport that will be valid on the date of the event. You can use the ticket for transportation to the airport/main train station.

Public transport in Prague

Prague has a very dense public transport infrastructure. More information is available at the <u>Prague Public Transport website</u>. To buy a ticket, you can use the vendor machines mostly located in the metro station foyers and at specific public transport stations. Tickets are also for sale in newsagent stores and in the public transport vehicles (only trams, contactless payment is required).



Accommodation

COVID - 19 measures

As of 9 April 2022, the Czech Republic suspended all COVID-19 related entry restrictions for travelers. Travelers to the Czech Republic are no longer required to complete a Passenger Locator Form, provide proof of COVID-19 vaccination or prior infection, etc.

All participants should observe basic hygiene measures during the Informal meeting (hand hygiene, respiratory hygiene). In accordance with the current Czech epidemic control regulations, <u>respirators are voluntary in all areas.</u>
